
Scouting for Food 2013 Map Book FAQ

What is in the map book?

- Overall Reference Maps and Index by Unit: pages i, ii, iii
- Unit Area Maps: pages A – J
- Street Maps: pages 1 – 77
- Index of Street Names: a1 – a3

How to use this map book:

If you want to find out what areas your unit is responsible for covering:

Use the color-coded legend on any map page. Match your unit with the color. The colors are the same throughout the entire map book. Pages A – J show one unit area per page to give you an overview of your Unit Area.

If you want to find out how many houses are in a particular area:

Use the charts on the front of page i to find totals for unit areas as well as sub-areas. Sub-area address totals are labeled inside each sub-area on pages A – J.

If you want to find the pages that contain street-level maps for your unit:

Use the index on page iii to find all of the pages that contain your unit areas. You can then selectively print those pages to hand out to your unit.

If you want to find a particular street:

Use the Index of Street Names at the end of the map book on pages a1 – a3 to find out the pages that contain the street you are interested in viewing.
